

A Small Guide to Transportation in France

For IPAC'26 Participants – Travelling to Deauville

Welcome to France!

We are truly delighted to welcome you to **IPAC'26 in Deauville**.

Many participants will be travelling internationally, sometimes across multiple time zones. To facilitate your arrival, this guide provides clear and practical information about transportation options from Paris to Deauville. Please be reassured: France has a well-developed and reliable public transportation network, and reaching Deauville from Paris is straightforward once you know the steps.

Since participants are expected to arrive on **Friday** and no shuttle service is scheduled that day, this guide explains clearly and carefully how to reach Deauville independently.

You will find below a simple, step-by-step explanation of the optimal routes.

1. The Main Journey: Paris to Deauville

All recommended routes include a regional train from [Gare Saint-Lazare](#) to [Gare de Deauville-Trouville](#)

Tickets can be booked on the official website of the French national railway company: [SNCF](#).

You should search for:

- **From:** Paris Saint-Lazare
- **To:** Deauville - Trouville

The journey takes approximately from **2 to 3 hours**.

We recommend booking your train ticket in advance, especially if you are travelling on Friday, as trains can become busy.

After your search, the booking page should look similar to this:

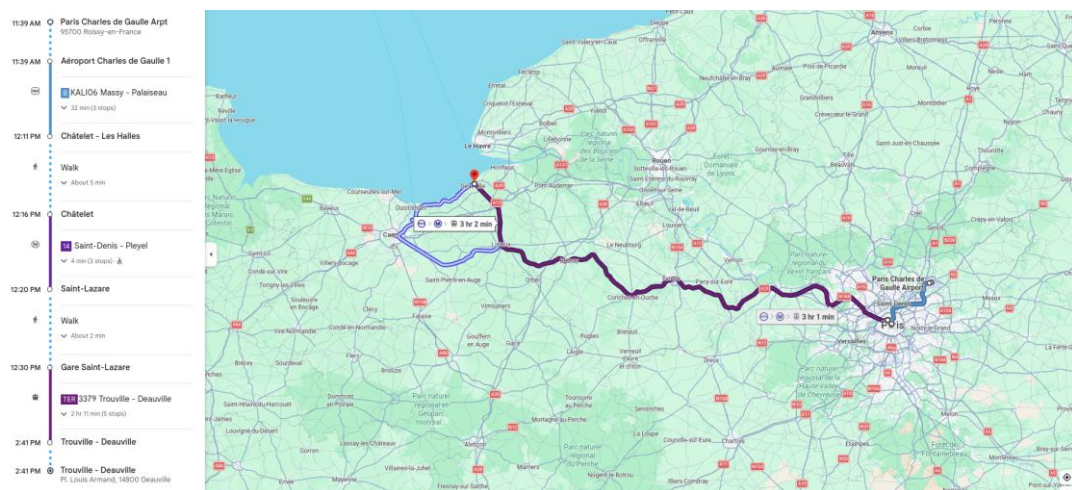
2. Reaching Gare Saint-Lazare from Paris Airports

From Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG)

Step-by-step:

1. Take the **RER B** train towards Paris.
2. Stop at **Châtelet–Les Halles** station.
3. Transfer to **Metro Line 14**, direction **Saint-Denis**.
4. Get off at **Gare Saint-Lazare**.

🕒 Total travel time: approximately **45 minutes**. Example :

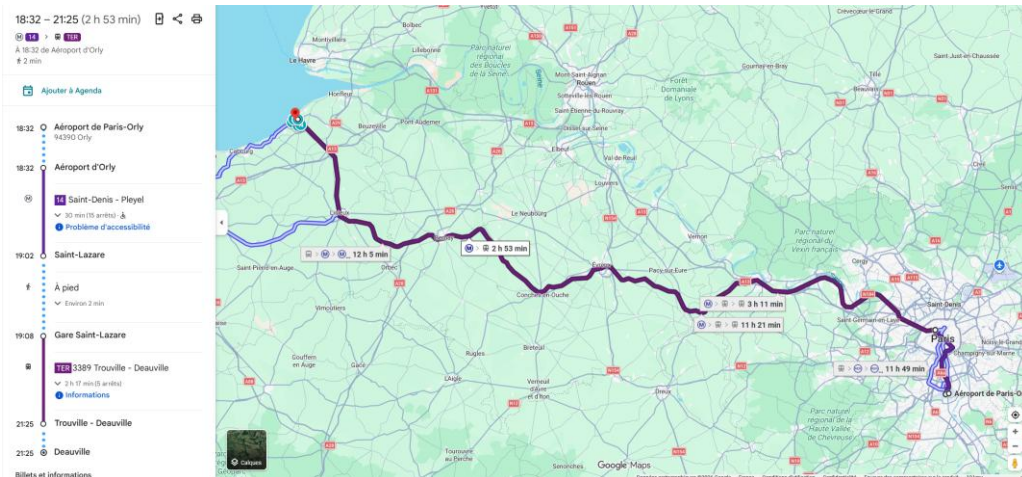


From Paris Orly Airport (ORY)

Step-by-step:

1. Take **Metro Line 14** directly from Orly Airport.
2. Direction: **Saint-Denis**.
3. Stop at **Gare Saint-Lazare**.

🕒 Total travel time: approximately **30 minutes**. Example :



This is the simplest route.

From Major Paris Train Stations (if arriving by train)

- From **Gare du Nord** → Take **RER E** to Saint-Lazare.
- From **Gare de Lyon** → Take **Metro Line 14** to Saint-Lazare.

These transfers are simple and well signposted.

3. How to Buy a Metro / RER Ticket



In airports and train stations, you will find automatic ticket machines like the ones shown above. On the left, you can find the « services » office. Do not hesitate to ask them questions

if you have. They can also sell tickets if you have troubles with the machines, but are usually quite busy.

To buy your ticket:

1. Select **English language** (available on all machines).
2. Choose your destination (e.g., *Gare Saint-Lazare*).
3. Pay by card or cash.
4. Collect your ticket.

⚠ Important:

Keep your ticket until the very end of your journey. You will need it to exit through the automatic gates.

4. Arrival in Deauville



Once you arrive at **Deauville - Trouville** station, you are almost there!

Deauville is a **small and elegant seaside town**. All conference venues, hotels, and main points of interest are within **walking distance** of the train station.



No additional transportation is normally required.

Final Advice

- Allow comfortable connection time between airport arrival and your train to Deauville.
- Do not hesitate to ask staff for help : most speak basic English.
- Keep your tickets until you exit each station.
